The result was virtually indestructible glass enclosures that protect players and officials while on the bench. The glass provides outstanding transparency and a superior appearance.



The benches were recently used at the FIFA Confederations Cup in June, a prelude to the World Cup, and will be used at the 2014 World Cup.

“Even if a player made a direct, full-force shot at the roof, no crack would appear,” said AGC.
